Telangana Innovation Cell Achieves Statewide Reach with Phase II of TGIC Hosts Initiative

Telangana Incubators Chart Collaborative Path Forward



On April 24th, 2025, representatives from Telangana's diverse incubator network gathered at **T-Hub** for another fascinating monthly roundtable. The primary objective was to strengthen collaboration and strategize for collective impact within the state's startup ecosystem.

The session featured insightful addresses from **Meraj Faheem**, CEO of **Telangana Innovation Cell (TGIC)**, and **Kavikrut**, CEO of **T-Hub**. Both leaders underscored the importance of a united focus on supporting the founders. The discussion facilitated a vibrant exchange of ideas on how incubators could collectively enhance their support for founders across the state.

Kavikrut emphasized that collaboration, rather than competition, was crucial for ecosystem growth, referencing T-Hub's nine years of contributions and its consistent 'Founders First' approach. Meraj highlighted the role of incubators as 'spaces of hope' and stressed the need for a shared belief in the potential of startups.

A key challenge identified during the meeting was the existing lack of consistent communication among the various incubators. To address this, Kavikrut proposed a shift towards providing deeper, more substantive support to startups. He also expressed that incubators should collectively define a significant, collaborative initiative designed to directly benefit Telangana's startup community.

These meetings signify a concerted effort to foster a more integrated and supportive environment for entrepreneurs in Telangana, aiming to leverage collective strengths for broader ecosystem development.
